

Cheery Holiday Scarf

In this quick-to-knit fringed scarf, use 4 strands of fingering weight yarn held together to create your own stunning marled color combination. *Maybe use up some stash in the process, too!*

Sizing and Materials Details

Sizes: One size.

Finished measurements: Approximately 5.5"/14 cm wide x 60"/150 cm long, excluding fringe.

Gauge: 13 sts and 14 rows = 4"/10 cm in pattern using size needle to obtain gauge.

Needles: US 13 (9 mm) or size needed for gauge. *Adjust needle size as necessary to obtain the correct gauge.*

Yarn: Approximately 200 yards EACH of four strands of fingering weight (CYCA #1) yarn, plus extra for fringe. To work the scarf in one strand of yarn, use 200 yards of bulky weight (CYCA #6) yarn, plus extra for fringe.

The sample scarf shows 2 strands of Hand Dyed Yarns by Shaina "Bounce" (85% Superwash Merino Wool, 15% Nylon; 394 yds/100 g), 1 ball.

Held together with 2 strands of Hand Dyed Yarns by Shaina "Whirl" (Boucle - 100% Superwash Merino Wool; 492 yds/100 g), 1 ball.

Fringe was made with 1 mini skein of Yarns by Shaina "Bounce" (78 yds/20 g).

Other Materials: Tapestry needle, scissors, size K (7mm) crochet hook for attaching fringe.

Abbreviations

k – knit.
k1tbl – knit one stitch through the back loop.
p – purl.
RS – right side (outside) of the fabric.
sl1wyif - slip one stitch purlwise with yarn in front.
st/sts - stitch/stitches.
WS – wrong side (inside) of the fabric.

Notes

Cast on sts in multiples of 2 to make the scarf wider or narrower.

Instructions

With size US 13 (9 mm) needles and four strands of fingering weight yarn held together, cast on 18 sts.

Rows 1-4: K1tbl, *k1, p1; repeat from * to the last st, sl1wyif.

Rows 5-8: K1tbl, *p1, k1; repeat from * to the last st, sl1wyif.

Repeat Rows 1-8 until the scarf measures 60"/150 cm or desired length after completing Row 3 or Row 7.

Bind off in pattern on Row 4 or Row 8.



Finishing

Weave in ends. Steam the scarf.

Fringe

Cut fringe into 12"/30 cm (or desired) lengths. Holding 6 strands together, attach the fringe evenly across the cast on and bind off edges of the scarf.

Tip: Use a size K (7 mm) crochet hook to help grab the fringe yarn by inserting the hook from the WS to the RS of the scarf and pulling the center point of the fringe through. Bring the fringe tails through the loop and tighten.

Steam, comb, and trim the fringe evenly.
