
# Convergence Wrap





A simple stockinette poncho wrap made for everyday wear.

## Sizing and Materials Details

Sizes: Small/Medium (Large/X-Large)

Finished measurements: Small/Medium: 22" x 46" before seaming, 22" x 23" after seaming.

Large/X-Large: 25" x 54" before seaming, 25" x 27" after seaming.

**Gauge**: 18 stitches and 26 rows = 4" in stockinette stitch

**Needles**: US 7 (4.5 mm) needles. Adjust needle size as necessary to obtain correct gauge. **Yarn**: 800 (1200) yards fingering weight (CYCA #1) yarn. Sample made with Zen Yarn

Garden Serenity 20 (70% superwash merino wool, 20% cashmere, 10% nylon, 400 yds / 100 g).

Other Materials: tapestry needle.

# Special Stitches

Stockinette Stitch Row 1 (RS): knit. Row 2 (WS): purl.

Repeat rows 1 and 2 for pattern.

#### Instructions

Using the crochet cast on (or any other cast on you choose), cast on 100 stitches for Small/Medium or 112 stitches for Large/X-Large. Work in stockinette stitch until piece measures 46" for the Small/Medium or 54" for the Large/X-Large from the beginning. Bind off.

## Finishing

Seam the wrap together:

- 1. Fold the wrap in half, matching cast on edge to bind off edge.
- 2. Using mattress stitch, seam along one side edge from the cast on/bind off edge toward the fold, leaving 11" down from the fold open. Neck opening will have a finished circumference of 22".
- 3. Weave in tails
- 4. Wet block for best drape and to help uncurl the edges.

If you desire, you can get extra yarn and work a crochet border around the piece. You can also work the wrap up in a different stitch pattern. Have fun!
